

We have enjoyed helping to care for the health needs of your children this year! There are many things to think about as we approach the last couple weeks of school. Here are just a few reminders:

End of School Year Medication Pick up - Please pick up ALL medications from the school office by 12pm on June 2nd. Medications **cannot** be sent home with students. The school **cannot** store medication in the office over the summer. Any unclaimed medications will be destroyed in accordance with local, state, and federal laws.

New Health Forms for 2023-24 - With each new school year, it is necessary to update your child's Health Forms for school. Please submit a new form (Emergency Action Plan, Medical Management Plan, Treatment Authorization Form, etc) into the office when school resumes in August.

If your child will require medications while at school next year, you must complete a Medication Administration Consent form for each medication to be given at school. Both prescription and over-the-counter medications require a consent form signed by both parents and physician.

If you would like for your student to carry emergency medication, such as an inhaler, epi-pen, or glucagon/diabetes supplies; please be sure to also complete the "Self Carry/Administer Medication" section of the Medication Administration Consent form.
