

F.R.O.M. Food Fight School and District Competition

The Lowell High School Interact Club works with Flat River Outreach Ministries to jump start the 2015 F.R.O.M. "Food Fight". We will be collecting nonperishable food items for the local food pantry from April 18th – May 23rd.

School Competition: Interact, Early Act and Student Council students will be helping the High School, Middle School, Murray Lake, Alto, Cherry Creek Elementary and Bushnell with a friendly competition. Classrooms in each school will be competing against each other in an effort to help people in our own community. Each classroom will be trying to collect the most non-perishable food items to collect food items and track the competition. **The classroom/hour with the most items wins a pizza party!**

- Counting and Collecting Food Items:
 - Each school will have leaders in their school collect, count, and tally the totals for each class on a weekly basis. We will provide each school with a tally sheet to keep track of weekly totals.
 - Food items will be counted every Friday over the course of the five weeks of the competition.
 - The running total for each classroom will be displayed. There will also be a running total for each school on display at each school.
- Advertising
 - Principals will send information to parents through parent blasts in April & May
 - Teachers will talk with students about how the competition works, and how our local food pantry works in our community.
 - Student Council Members & Early Act will be making posters to post around the school.
- Prize
 - The Interact Club will provide the winning class in each school with a pizza party on a date that the winning class chooses. Interact and Student Council Students will be joining the party.
 - This year there will be a trophy the schools can display!

District Wide Competition: Each school in the district will be competing against one another in an effort to collect as many non-perishable food items as possible. The winner between the High School, Middle School, Cherry Creek Elementary, Alto Elementary, Murray Lake Elementary and Bushnell will have bragging rights for the next school year and will be able to display a large trophy wherever they please!

Traveling Trophy will be awarded to the winning principal at the end of the school year!
