## Instructions

- Gather all unwanted medication from drawers, medicine cabinets, etc.
- Leave items in their original containers.
- Check the list to see what can go to pharmacies and what can't.
- Bring accepted items to the proper location.
- Personal Information will not be collected.
- Do not remove label but black out all personal information from prescription label. You need to leave the name of the medicine on the label.



## Pharmacies

- ✓ Non-controlled Prescription medications.
- ✓ Over the counter medications.
- ✓ Medication samples
- ✓ Medications for pets
- ✓ Vitamins
- ✓ Medicated ointments/lotions
- ✓ Liquid medicine in glass or leak proof containers (up to 12oz).

## Law Enforcement Drop Boxes

Narcotic pain killers, prescribed controlled medications.

*Examples:*

*Codeine, Xanax, Valium, Hydrocodone, Ambien, Vicodin, OxyContin, Percocet, Ritalin, etc.*



## NOT ACCEPTED

- × **NO Sharps:** Needles/syringes/epipens
- × Thermometers
- × IV Bags
- × Bloody or Infectious Waste
- × Hydrogen Peroxide
- × Isopropyl alcohol
- × Business Waste
- × Empty containers
- × Aerosol cans
- × Personal care products (shampoos, cosmetics, suntan lotions, etc.).
