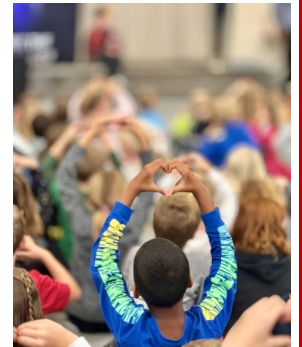
Reminders:
