# A Message from Food Service...

Murray Lake students got to try some new, healthy snacks provided by Chef Brad and Dietitian, Mindy Grant, from Lowell Food Service. Many students asked for the recipes so they could enjoy these healthy treats at home:

### Pumpkin Hummus

- 1 Can Chickpeas, drained (liquid reserved)
- 1 Lemon, juiced
- ½ Cup Tahini
- 1 Clove Garlic
- 3/4 tsp Salt

2 Tbls Reserved Chickpea Liquid

(or skip the steps above and use 2 cups of store bought hummus)

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Cup Pumpkin Pie Filling

½ tsp Pumpkin Pie Spice

1 Tbls Brown Sugar (optional)

Add the first 5 ingredients to a food processor. Blend until smooth. Add more chickpea liquid, if you feel it is too dry. Add pumpkin pie filling, pumpkin pie spice, and brown sugar if using. Pulse and blend until it is well incorporated.

## Avocado Mango Smoothie

- ½ Cup Ice
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Avocado
- 1/4 Cup Fresh or Frozen Mango
- 1 Tbls Honey
- 1 Tbls Lime
- ½ Cup Pineapple Juice

Puree all ingredients in a blender until smooth.
