We had our first student council meeting this week for kids in grades 3-5. This was an informational meeting on the program itself. If students were interested, they took a permission slip to be signed by parents/guardians. Student Council is a great leader-ship opportunity where students can be the voice for their classroom and the school to help make MLE an even better place to learn. If you have a 3rd, 4th, or 5th grader, talk to them about this opportunity! More information about elections and representatives will be coming home soon.

In the next few weeks, we will finish up our Acadience Reading Testing. MAP testing will begin as well. MAP testing will take at least 3 weeks to complete. After that, our students and teachers will begin goal setting. Our teachers will be blocking out some time to speak with our students about the importance of setting goals. Each of our students will set goals for this school year. These goals will include academic and affective goals dealing with our Positive Behavior Intervention and Support system. Our older students will review their fall MAP (Measurement of Academic Progress) scores to help them set their academic goals. Research shows that students who set goals have a much higher chance of being successful adults. Take some time to share with your children, the goals you have in your life. You have the most impact on your child and if he/she sees that goal setting is important to you, he/she will also think it is important. Also, ask your child what he/she wants to be when he/she grows up. It is never too early to have these discussions with your children. They may change their minds over the years, but what's important is that they are thinking about the future, and seeing how doing well in school will relate to being successful later on in life.

Did you know that the first Friday of each month is Ice Cream Friday? We sell ice cream treats for \$1 at lunch. If your child is interested in this opportunity, please send \$1 to school with them. They can take that money to lunch with them and once they finish eating, they can enjoy a cold treat! We do offer dairy free options as well!

Today (2nd Friday of each month) our School Store is open. This store is a money based store where kids can purchase trinkets, fun school supplies, and other goodies. If your child would like to shop, please send him/her to school with money. Most items are priced from .50 cents to \$2.00. This is totally optional but students do love shopping at our School Store. We also have a Mustang Market which is open the last week of each month. This store is where students spend their Mustang Moments (token economy) on toys, trinkets, or drawings for various things. They earn Mustang Moments by showing that they are safe, respectful, and responsible throughout the school day.

We have had another great week here at MLE. I see our students putting our PBIS traits into action daily! They are being Safe, Responsible and Respectful, and we appreciate this! RESEPCT is our focus word for the month of September. At the end of this month, students from each class have a chance to be nominated for showing great respect in the class and/or school. Each month we will have a new focus area, and throughout the year, students will be nominated and receive an award and pin for their lanyard.
