### **Supply List**

The following items are suggested classroom materials that you can purchase for your son/daughter. Having these items on hand will help to prepare your child for the first day of school. We understand families may not be able to purchase all of these items due to financial concerns. Supplies will be provided to all students as needed.

#### **Kindergarten**

- 3 24-count boxes of Crayola crayons
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 box of facial tissues
- 1 box of Crayola markers (thin)
- Computer headphones (optional)
- 4 dry-erase markers (thin, black markers preferred)
- 1 container of Clorox wipes

#### **First Grade**

- 1 box of facial tissues
- 1 16-count box of Crayola crayons
- 1 large pink eraser
- 1 package #2 pencils (12 sharpened)
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 set of colored pencils (12 sharpened)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 plastic pencil box
- Headphones
- 1 pencil/crayon sharpener
- Disinfectant wipes

#### **Second Grade**

- 1 package of #2 pencils (sharpened if possible)
- Pencil box or bag (w/ zipper)
- 2 large, pink erasers (not jumbo size)
- 1 box of markers
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of crayons

- 1 package of dry erase markers (any color)
- 2 pocket take home folder (any style)
- 2 glue sticks
- Scissors
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 1-2 boxes of tissues
- Hand sanitizer – 8 oz bottle
- 1 clipboard (w/ name on it)
- Headphones (in a ziplock bag w/ name on it)
- Optional: 1 bag of candy for classroom reward bin; 1 box of plastic bags – girls-sandwich or snack; boys-quart or gallon size

### **Third Grade**

- Colored pencils
- Crayons (24 count)
- 24-36 pencils
- 1-2 Yellow Highlighters
- 8 black dry-erase markers
- 2-4 sticky note pads
- Erasers
- 3-4 glue sticks
- 3 spiral notebooks, wide ruled, single subject
- 1 composition notebook, wide ruled (any color)
- Hand-held sharpener with compartment to hold shavings (not battery operated)
- 1-2 large boxes of facial tissue
- Small pencil box
- Headphones or earbuds
- 2-pocket folders with prongs (1 red, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 purple, 1 yellow)
- 2-pocket poly plastic folders (1 red, 1 any color besides black)
- 1 white 1” Clear View binder (has a clear pocket on the cover)
- Tab dividers for 3-ring binder (5 dividers total)
- No Trapper Keepers please. These are too big for the desks. No markers.
